

HOW DO THE FRIENDS HELP?

The Friends is a non-profit volunteer group formed to increase public interest and participation in West Slope Community Library and to strengthen the library's collection, activities, and fiscal well-being.

We help pay for books, programs, and other library needs. Our library funding comes from Washington County property tax levies. Since public funding can be subject to change, the Friends can help provide a financial "safety net" in case regular Washington County funding is not sufficient.

HOW IS THE FRIENDS GROUP FUNDED?

Funding comes from memberships, donations, bequests, our in-house book sales, and our annual tulip sale.
